*O.N.L.U.S., has wrote the following guideline for a nice cohabitation between humans and dogs.*

1. Dogs must wear leash and collar at all times, the use of muzzle is not mandatory if the dog is not nipping. The owner must be always vigilant.
2. Dogs are allowed to transit public areas and not in private areas or in the apartment's gardens.
3. The owner must always equipped with pet waste bags and small shovel if necessary.
4. The dog can be left in the apartment garden provided that it's tied and has a water bowl.
5. The dog must not cause a disturbance to neighours. Owner must not leave the dog alone unless it can cope with separation anxiety.
6. Nipping dogs can not be allowed into the residence in case they might be harmful to other guests.
7. In making a reservation the residence must be informed of any in heat female for it may be bothering if males are around.
8. External strolls are welcome to make pets poo away from the residence (the use of shovel and waste bag remains still mandatory)
9. Two dogs who don't know eachother must come near with caution to avoid futile fights.
10. The dog owners must present themselves at the reception when making a reservation with the dog health book in order with the vaccinations and a recent good health certificate which says that the animal is not infested with external or internal parasites. The owners must have the policy of civil responsability with them in case that the dog causes any damage to people or things.
11. The guest will have to look after the tideness (fur, etc..) and apartment sanitation at departure.
12. Pool guideline – Dogs are allowed in the pool area near the Teti pool. A pool is at your disposal for dogs who want to take a bath. There is the possibility to upstream swimming (on demand). Dogs must be on a leash and not free to roam and must be carefully watched to cause no annoyance to other guests.
